The second ballot is to vote on updates to both the club's Constitution as well as its By-Laws. The votes for this ballot will be tallied on April 7th at the Picture Party at the Villa Nova West. The details of these changes are listed with the ballot, but I will attempt to summarize them here:

Constitution Update - adds a note that allows the club to officially refer to itself as the Lancaster Ski and Snowboard Club. This will better allow us to market and advertise ourselves to attract members and enthusiasts that may otherwise not be connected to us.

By-law update #1 - an update to our anti-discrimination clause. We are proud of our anti-discriminatory philosophy and inclusive membership. This change better affirms this position.

By-Law update #2 - an update to the stated membership fee. This change will allow the Board of Directors to have the flexibility to better manage the club's finances and keep the club operating in a fiscally responsible manner.

There are still several events coming up this season. Mark your calendars for the next membership meeting at Loxley's on March 16, the Picture Party at the Villa Nova West on April 7, and the Spring Dance at Meadia Heights, on April 22.

Roger and Alice Brubaker went home with their prize possessions for some fun times.

Many of our members really worked at getting a great number of gift certificates from local stores and restaurants. They also brought many nice items such as theater tickets, Jay and Jason's box of homemade canned goods, Hedy's handmade wine cork bird house, a new wine corkscrew set, new carpenter's level, many gift baskets, slightly used skis, new poles, and dozens of items which went for top dollar.

Toward the end of the second page of items the two LSC Member's Dinners appeared and that's when the crowd went on a spending spree! 
