All event fees will be collected at Sickman's Mill and not in advance. Individuals tubing will arrive at 11:30 and then obtain their own tubing tickets directly from Sickman's, before assembling with the club to float down the creek at 12:00. Lunch will begin at 1:30, when LSC will collect the lunch fee. It's completely acceptable to skip the tubing and just attend the lunch!

Lunch includes hot dogs, hamburgers, chips, drinks, and s'mores (bring your own marshmallow roasting stick). Side dishes and/or desserts to share are welcomed and encouraged. Note that LSC will not be providing alcohol at the event; however, beer and wine are permitted but only during the lunch (no drinks allowed while tubing). Sickman's also operates an on-site concession stand.

Kids are welcome at the entire event if accompanied by a responsible family member!


