# Trip Committee Update

The Trip Committee is wishing you all a healthy and safe Thanksgiving!!

The Powder Mt./ Snowbasin March 13-17, 2021 trip is now priced at \$1369.00pp/ dbl. occ. This trip will now have everyone arriving to the PHL Airport providing their own transportation. We have a direct flight out of PHL at 5:45pm on Saturday afternoon. There are only 28 seats for this trip and the trip is open to members from other clubs. There are ONLY 13 seats left for this trip. We will need to release all remaining airline seats by Wednesday December 2, 2020.

So now is the time to sign up for the Powder Mt./ Snowbasin, Utah trip before the trip sells out!! Utah is one of the few states that does NOT have any type of quarantine in place for visitors coming into their state.

Please check the website and the November Newsletter for information and the sign-up procedure for the Elk Mt./ Greek Peak Weekend scheduled for January 22-23/24, 2021. Since this is a drive-up trip there are three different price options for this trip. After you sign up Online or by check, please contact the Registration Coordinator on what package you would like for the weekend.

The Trip Committee is still working on pricing for another one-night trip. When priced this trip will be sold as drive to the mountain/s trips. Bus transportation will not be provided.

The planning of day trips will run as bus trips at this time.

Please note: Trip leaders will not room any more than two people per room and will do their best to room those without requested roomies; single supplement fees may be implemented for those that do not have a roomie or do not get assigned one.

## What Should I Expect from Ski Resorts This Season?

Will it be different? Yes! What should I do? Be Prepared! The best way for you to enjoy a day on any mountain this year is to Plan Ahead! Check sites or call your favorite mountain prior to any travel and ask what policies they have in place. The last thing you want to do is get to a mountain and find out that they do not have room for you, your family, or friends that day to ski or board.

### Important Changes:

- Reservations Online or advanced group sales will be mandatory to ski or board at many mountains this year.
- No ticket sales at windows this year for most mountains.
- Masks will be required everywhere. Including on the mountain and in the gondolas and chair lifts. Some mountains will even be doing temperature screening.
- Lockers will be extremely limited.
- Benches near lockers will be extremely limited.
- Mountains are asking that you boot up at your car.
- No outside food (picnic lunch) will be allowed at any seating space.
- Tailgating in the parking lot is being recommended.
- Restaurant seating will be extremely limited.
- Lift lines will be spaced out.
- Please put the ski patrol number of the mountain you visit in your cell phone. There will be less ski patrollers on the mountain this year.
- Blue Mt. is not allowing adult bus groups at their mountain for a day trip.

### Travel Restrictions for New England:

- Travel restrictions are in effect throughout New England and are updated regularly.
- Several states require either quarantine for 14 days or 7 days with a negative COVID test. It is important to check travel advisory sites regularly.

### On the positive side:

- Less people on the mountain which in turn is more runs per day. Whoo Hoo!!!
- Less people at one time on lifts and gondolas. Vents will be open on gondolas.
- **If you have not joined one of our trips before, this is the time to join! Groups booked in advance** and season ticket holders with Ikon or Epic passes will be granted access to the mountain ahead of those wanting to sign up a few days in advance.
