LSC SHOW N' GO BIKE RIDE

Saturday September 12, 2020

Cycle on the Northwest Lancaster County River Trail. Ride along the picturesque Susquehanna River. Enjoy the scenery and some notable points of interest – iron furnaces, an eagles nest, white cliffs of Conoy, Shock's Mill Railroad Bridge, and an abandoned canal bed. C'mon out and have some fun with LSC!

No need to RSVP - - Just "SHOW" up and be ready to "GO" by 10:00am.



We'll be starting at the Riverfront Park Pavilion which is near the midpoint of the trail at 10:00am. Directions from Lancaster: Route 30 west to Columbia route 441 exit, north (go right) on route 441 for 5.5 miles, left on Vinegar Ferry Road, continue under railroad bridge, right turn to parking (free) and the pavilion. Meet at the pavilion.

The flat, mostly wooded trail follows the Susquehanna River and is paved for 11 miles between Columbia and Bainbridge with another 3.5 miles of gravel trail between Bainbridge and Falmouth. Ride in either or both directions for as long or far as you want. There are a couple of "job johnnies" along the trail and at the Park. Mountain, Road, or Hybrid bicycles are appropriate.

Apres' Ride - For anyone interested, we'll plan to gather around noon time for lunch and some well-earned beverages at McCleary's Public House (Irish Pub) at 130 W. Front Street in Marietta. Ride or drive there as it is adjacent to the trail.
