What Should I Expect from Ski Resorts This Season?

Will it be different? Yes! What should I do? Be Prepared! The best way for you to enjoy a day on any mountain this year is to Plan Ahead! Check sites or call your favorite mountain prior to any travel and ask what policies they have in place. The last thing you want to do is get to a mountain and find out that they do not have room for you, your family, or friends that day to ski or board.

Important Changes:

- Reservations Online or advanced group sales will be mandatory to ski or board at many mountains this year.
- No ticket sales at windows this year for most mountains.
- Masks will be required everywhere. Including on the mountain and in the gondolas and chair lifts. Some mountains will even be doing temperature screening.
- Lockers will be extremely limited.
- Benches near lockers will be extremely limited.
- Mountains are asking that you boot up at your car.
- No outside food (picnic lunch) will be allowed at any seating space.
- Tailgating in the parking lot is being recommended.
- Restaurant seating will be extremely limited.
- Lift lines will be spaced out.
- Please put the ski patrol number of the mountain you visit in your cell phone. There will be less ski patrollers on the mountain this year.
- Blue Mt. is not allowing adult bus groups at their mountain for a day trip.

Travel Restrictions for New England:

- Travel restrictions are in effect throughout New England and are updated regularly.
- Several states require either quarantine for 14 days or 7 days with a negative COVID test. It is important to check travel advisory sites regularly.

On the positive side:

- Less people on the mountain which in turn is more runs per day. Whoo Hoo!!!
- Less people at one time on lifts and gondolas. Vents will be open on gondolas.
- **If you have not joined one of our trips before, this is the time to join! Groups booked in advance** and season ticket holders with Ikon or Epic passes will be granted access to the mountain ahead of those wanting to sign up a few days in advance.
