# Trip Committee Update

**January 29, 2022 – February 6, 2022, Red Mountain, British Columbia/ Schweitzer Mountain, Idaho.** Both Red and Schweitzer are ICON Pass destinations. You may either sign up Online or send a check to the Trip Leader, Roger Brubaker. Roger only has 14 seats available at the current trip selling price. We may be able to get more seats if needed, but the current price cannot be guaranteed for the extra seats. This trip may be sold out prior to the upcoming Summer Picnic. So **NOW** is the time to get on this trip.

**Telluride, CO. This trip is scheduled for March 5-12, 2022.** Chris Lapes is the Trip Leader. Price is **ONLY \$1899.00/** per person/ quad occupancy, based on 4 people per a 2 bedroom/ 2 bath suite. The 2<sup>nd</sup> bedroom will be in a loft with a split-king bed with a private bathroom. You may either sign up Online or send a check to the Trip Leader.

The price of the Telluride trip does NOT include lift tickets. Telluride is an EPIC PASS mountain. EPIC PASSES and or a 5- or 6-Day EPIC PASS must be purchased from our Tour Operator for this trip at initial sign-up. That is if you do not already have an Epic Pass. Please check with Chris on Epic Pass pricing. For those that buy a Full Epic Pass, 4-, 5- or 6-day Epic Pass from our Tour Operator and you go on the Telluride trip with the Club, you will get a partial rebate for your Epic Pass at the end of the trip. The cost of this pass is non-refundable. Please contact Chris to get the full details.

Please check the current flyer for full details and the sign up and cancellation policy for both awesome trips. **You must be an up-to-date dues paying member to sign up for either one of these trips. If you are not a current member your check will be returned.**

The Trip Committee is working on Weekend trips and dates. Please keep an eye on the Website as trip information becomes available.

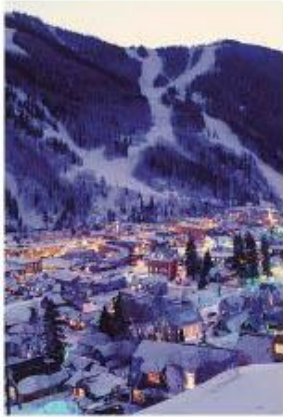

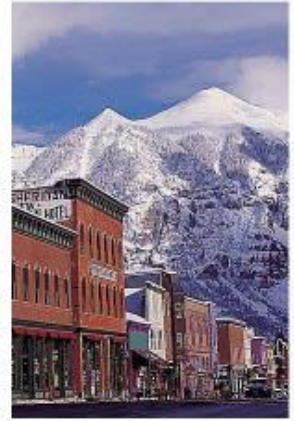

Good afternoon ski fanatics,

Well, is it feeling more like ski weather today than picnic weather but unfortunately we still have eight months before we takeoff for Spokane, WA and begin an exciting trip together! We are still early in the sign-up process however we already have twelve members onboard and a few more interested. We have a total of 32 spots reserved with a possibility of adding a few more if needed. I am expecting a full trip so if you know anyone who is thinking about joining us, I would encourage them to get a deposit sent in.

RED Mountain has been on my go to list ever since I ran a club trip to Silver Star, Revelstoke, and Kicking Horse in 2012. The club tried to run it last year but we all know how that worked out! I ran a trip to Schweitzer in March of 2015 and they were having the worst snow/weather in ten years at the resort! It has a great vibe and local feel. I am anxious to get back there and enjoy the skiing and the awesome views of Lake Pend Oreille, one of the deepest lakes in the country.

I have attached an updated trip flyer with final pricing and payment schedule. Since all of you have already paid a \$100 deposit you can simply deduct that from the amount showing as due. Of course you can always pay ahead or in full up front. The payment schedule is designed to help with your personal cashflow as well as meet our club requirements to make the initial deposit and all installment payments to the tour operator.

## FAQ

1. **Canadian Border** – We have until October 16<sup>th</sup> to cancel the trip with minimal cost to the club. I will continue to monitor the border status throughout the summer and communicate accordingly. It is possible there may be a negative COVID test requirement and/or proof of vaccination.
  2. **Exchange Rate** – Our trip contract is based on the current US-Canadian exchange rate. We have some protection built into the trip pricing to cover some fluctuation and I do not anticipate the price having to be changed unless there is a significant adjustment in the rate between now and January 2022.
  3. **Rent or take your own equipment** – This is often a question on major trips. Pros and cons to either option. One consideration with renting on this trip is that we are skiing at three different resorts and locations which means renting three times instead of one time. Current baggage fees on United are \$30 first bag, \$40 second bag. Second bag can consist of skis and boot bag. Let me know if you are interested in renting and I will try to get some group rates and information at each resort.
  4. **Non-skier Cost** – The cost of this trip for a non-skier is \$1,899.
  5. **ICON PASS** – Both RED Mountain and Schweitzer are on the ICON pass. Whitewater is not an ICON mountain therefore a one day lift ticket is included in the base trip price.
  6. **CAT and HELI** – Both Cat and Heli skiing are available at RED and Cat skiing is available at Schweitzer. This is an additional cost not included in the trip price. If you are interested please let me know and we can work out details.
- Passport** – All participants will need a current, valid passport to travel on this trip. Please review the US Dept of State website and familiarize yourself with restrictions to travel to Canada. Previous DUI and/or felony convictions may impact your ability to travel across the border. <https://travel.state.gov/content/travel/en/international-travel/International-Travel-Country-Information-Pages/Canada.html>
- Other Requirements** – All participants must a current LSC member, submit a completed a LSC Trip Application, submit a copy of current Passport, along with COVID health forms to be determined at a date closer to departure. <https://www.lancasterskiclub.net/trips>
