Wounded Warrior Patrol Info

The Wounded Warrior Patrol is a group of volunteer ski patrollers who organize and volunteer, leading up to a week each year working with Wounded Warriors and their families, so they can have an enriching, gratifying experience together, while skiing or snowboarding along with the patrollers helping them.

Their mission is to support the recovery and family bonding of Wounded Warriors, Warrior spouses, caregivers, and their children, through the recreational therapy of snow sports and other outdoor recreational activities. Wounded Warrior Patrol is not associated with the Wounded Warrior Project, and does not share funding, cooperation, or advertising with them.

The Wounded Warrior Patrol was formed based on the initial ties between the US Military and the National Ski Patrol during World War II. In homage to those veterans of the Greatest Generation, the Wounded Warrior Patrol was formed in the spring of 2011 founded on the need to pay it forward to the Wounded Warriors of this generation.

Based in the Carlisle area, the organization is run entirely by non-paid volunteers. The Wounded Warrior Patrol Board is comprised of ski patrollers, their family members, and friends - many of whom are veterans themselves. Currently, there are more than 20 active member volunteers who give countless hours each year to the planning and execution of their core mission.

Since 2012, the Wounded Warrior Patrol has offered an annual all-expenses paid ski vacation at Seven Springs Mountain Resort to selected Wounded Warriors, Veterans, and their families. These participants and their families can enjoy skiing, snowboarding, and other indoor and outdoor activities during this annual ski/snowboard event. No prior experience with skiing or snowboarding is necessary. For those unable to use skis or snowboards in a conventional manner, specialized instruction and adaptive ski equipment are provided. Ski instructors and ski buddies work with individuals, families, and groups, to ensure that everyone has as much time on the snow during this week as possible.

LSC is proud to offer support to this organization in the promotion of winter sporting.


